During the last research fellowship I compiled the bibliography of Jewish periodicals published in Transylvania since 1860.

The project aimed to identify and catalog the documents of the Jewish communities from Transylvania. In this process I worked on the cataloguing the documents of the Jewish communities of Cluj and Arad.

- During the 2018 grant I did research in the most important libraries in Transylvania and Hungary and I created the list of Transylvanian Jewish periodicals at the level of counties.
- During the 2019 grant I revealed the history of the *Új Kelet* (New East) newspaper, one of the most prestigious Jewish dailies of the time in Central and Eastern Europe.
- During the 2020 grant I examined how the Hungarian press of Transylvania presented the confiscation of Jewish movable and immovable properties.
